How is TK different from Kindergarten?

TK is a bridge from Preschool to Kindergarten. **It does not replace kindergarten.** The program uses the California Preschool Learning Foundations to lay a solid educational foundation and prepare our youngest learners for future academic success.

When can I sign my child up for Transitional Kindergarten?

The 2024-25 TK and Kindergarten enrollment window will run from November 13 - December 15. Completed online enrollment applications must be submitted by December 15 to be included in the first round of confirmation of space at the resident school site. We continue to accept TK and Kindergarten enrollment applications after December 15, they are received on a first come-first served basis for space.

Where do I enroll?

Our enrollment process is all online. The online enrollment application and forms are available on the San Ramon Valley Unified School District website at: www.srvusd.net/enrollyourchild.
